Brief History

The band's fifth and current live performance lineup features just one original member: guitarist/vocalist, founder, and band composer Randy Graves. Drummer/percussionist Kyle Nish handles the duties of rhythmic energy, with friends and studio musicians covering bass guitar, keyboards, and other instruments.

The band was first formed in Provo, Utah in 1975. They blend blues, classical, and art-rock music into their catalog of fiery progressive rock epics.

Studio Recordings

In 1985 Kalaban released their self-titled debut album as an independent release on cassette. Since then Kalaban has released four more studio records to critical acclaim. These are *Don't Panic* (SYN-PHONIC, 1992), *Resistance Is Useless* (SYN-PHONIC, 1994), *Turn to Flame* (Independent, 2010), and most recently in July 2017 *Edge Of Infinity* (Independent, 2017).

Live Performances

The later 1980s and early 1990s saw Kalaban performing many regional shows, including a co-headline show at the Utah Arts Festival with the Utah Symphony. To promote the release of *Don't Panic* and again the next year in support of *Resistance Is Useless*, Kalaban appeared before crowds of tens of thousands as a top-line act for the ProgFest series of festivals in California. The band was dormant from 1999 to 2013 as Randy and Michael Stout (long-time Kalaban band member) became involved in building a software company which was unrelated to music.

The 2017 version of the band is planning a tour of the Western US in support of the *Edge of Infinity* album.
